PARENT PARTICIPATION POLICY

1. Purpose:

The purpose of the policy aims to ensure students' overall development through active participation of their parents.

2. Aims of Policy

To ensure active involvement of student, teacher and parent for continual improvement of the students and the positive progress of the school at par with the School's Vision and Mission statements.

3. Policies:

- 3.1 Parent teacher council (PTC) should consist of parents from diverse social and economic strata, school representatives and the same should be re-constituted every 2 years.
- 3.2 Parents representatives can either nominate themselves or be nominated by the school authorities.
- 3.3 Representative for the PTC will be selected by the parents and some professionally talented parents will be nominated by the school to this body.
- 3.4 Conduct regular parent teachers' meetings.
- 3.5 Collecting feedback from the parents through online survey, parent/ teacher/ Principal/ Head of Section communication through school diary for continual improvement of the school.
- 3.6 All major changes that are planned will be conveyed and discussed during the Parent Teacher Council meetings prior to its implementation.
- 3.7 Organizing workshops and presentations by the department of counselling, expert and specialist/resource persons on career development for students along with their parents.
- 3.8 Parents should also be invited for formal and informal school events/functions such as school annual day, art and science exhibitions, sports day, etc. to witness the ward(s) contribution and also to review the work of other students.
- 3.9 All communication will be through ERP.
