M.E.S Indian School Achieves Historic Excellence by producing record breaking results in the CBSE Class XII Examination 2025 – Emerges Qatar Topper across all Three Streams, Bringing Pride to the Institution.

- In the **Science Stream** Aneena Mariya Kurikose emerged as school topper with 98.2%
- **Commerce Stream** witnessed Maliha Mumtaz Najeeb securing first position with 97.4%
- In the **Humanities Stream**, Jiya Maria Jude topped the school with 96.4% marks.
- About 12 students secured a perfect **score of 100** in various subjects.
- A total of **561** students appeared for the CBSE Board Examination, and the school is proud to have achieved a 100% pass result, reflecting its unwavering commitment to academic excellence.
