Students of classes **V to XII** are eligible to participate. The Exhibition is categorized as follows:

- Category 1** : V & VI
Category 2 : VII & VIII
Category 3 : IX & X
Category 4 : XI & XII

General Rules & Regulations:

1. Each entry should be the original work of the participant.
2. Only two students per exhibit will be permitted. One student can participate only in one activity.
3. The maximum space allotted per exhibit is **1.5 m x 1m**.
4. Best three exhibits from each category will be awarded with prizes and certificates.
5. From each **Category**, the exhibits which are beneficial for the society will be awarded with **Special Prizes and Certificates**.
